NAFF It Project 2016 Dates
Monday 25 July - Thursday 28 July

Eligibility and Selection criteria

- 1. A feature-length film project (running time 60 mins or longer) for theatrical release
- 2. Application materials should be in English.
- 3. Either a director or producer should be attached.
- 4. At any stage of production from development, pre-production, production to post-production. The project that will have completed before the time of NAFF 2016 shall not be accepted.
- 5. A project that is NOT fully financed
- 6. A project that has been selected or supported by other organizations/funds may apply except when it is fully supported financially

Submission requirements

- 1. A completed project entry form (by online)
- 2. Synopsis
- 3. Director's Statement in full sentences
- 4. Director's Profile in full sentences
- 5. Producer's Profile in full sentences
- 6. Production Company's Profile in full sentences
- 7. Production Schedule (as detailed as possible)





Submissions optional materials (if possible, not required)

- 1. Treatment
- 2. Full Script (Electronic format)
- 3. Director's previous work(s) (online streaming platforms)
- 4. Footage or trailer of the project (online streaming platforms)

Benefits of NAFF selected projects

1. A round flight ticket and 4-night accommodation will be offered for a director and 4-night

accommodation for a producer of each selected project.

2. Complimentary badges that give a whole access to NAFF and BiFan 2016 will be offered to project representatives.

Conditions for NAFF selected projects

1. At least one representative from the project MUST attend all the scheduled meetings during the four days of NAFF (Monday 25 July to Thursday 28 July 2016).

2. Project representatives cannot veto on any meetings at any reason.

(With a prior notice, meetings can be re-scheduled.)

3. NAFF will not provide any kind of translation or interpretation service at any meetings. If project representatives would bring their own translator, a day pass will be given to the individual.

4. The completed feature films, based on the projects presented to the NAFF It Project 2016 shall

mention in their end credits the following: "NAFF It Project 2016 – logo". The NAFF logo will be sent to the filmmakers or editors upon request.

Awards

1. Among NAFF 2016 selections, a number of outstanding projects will be given a cash reward or support for the post-production by our sponsors at the NAFF Awards & Closing ceremony.

2. All projects are obliged to meet with NAFF Jury members and the representatives of our sponsors for purpose of consideration of the awards.

3. The completed feature films, based on the projects presented to NAFF 2016 and awarded by the sponsors shall mention in their end credits the following: "NAFF It Project 2016" accompanied by NAFF logo. .

4. Our sponsors may request written agreements to the awardees on the specific points about citation before the payment.





Notes to Applicants:

1. One applicant can apply several different projects. However, one submission form is for one project submission only.

2. For Korean language project submissions, all supporting materials can be submitted in Korean for submissions. However, the materials should be provided in Korean and English both languages once the project gets selected.

3. All submissions must adhere to entry character limits.

4. Materials and information supplied will be treated as confidential and will be used by NAFF and

Bucheon International Fantastic Film Festival (BiFan) only.

5. All materials submitted will not be returned.
